Dear Community Members,

I write this in the interim between the celebration of two great Sacraments. Last Sunday, on the External Solemnity of Corpus Christi, three young ladies received our Divine Lord for the first time. This Sunday, 12 young people will become soldiers of Christ by receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. How blessed and privileged we are to have such great things here in this church. How honored we must be to see God carry out his sacramental plan of salvation in our very midst.

This week, we will see some changes in our life here. I expect the arrival of Father Orłowski before we see one another this Sunday. I will also have to bid a sad farewell to my dear sister who has been with me since 23 June. All of you know, by this time, that she is unwell and anticipating the day when she'll be able to receive a liver transplant. Until then, things will continue to become more and more difficult for her, unfortunately. But how blessed have I been to be able to care for her these three short weeks. This time has enabled me give back a small fraction of the love and affection she has always born me.

I do hope you will all make the effort to arrive as early as you can for the 11AM Mass. Confirmation will take place before Mass and I have prevailed on His Excellency to carry out the Asperges rite for us prior to the beginning of Mass. I wanted to get him involved in the liturgy apart from Confirmation. This will be a way for him to get his Episcopal feet wet.

Shortly after the Confirmation reception, I will, once again, have to be on my way to Nebraska. This time, for the annual priests' retreat. I will again spend the night in Father Define's rectory and he and I will set out for Nebraska the next day. But this time, no Masses will have to be cancelled, since Father Orłowski will be with us and will celebrate all scheduled Masses with their intentions. I plan to return Friday.

Two more events before the summer doldrums: The External Solemnity of Ss. Peter and Paul, when our own Caroline Davis will come into the Church, and our laid back patronal feast. Then, a very even-keel summer, my children and my friends.
