

Little Rock National Life Chain

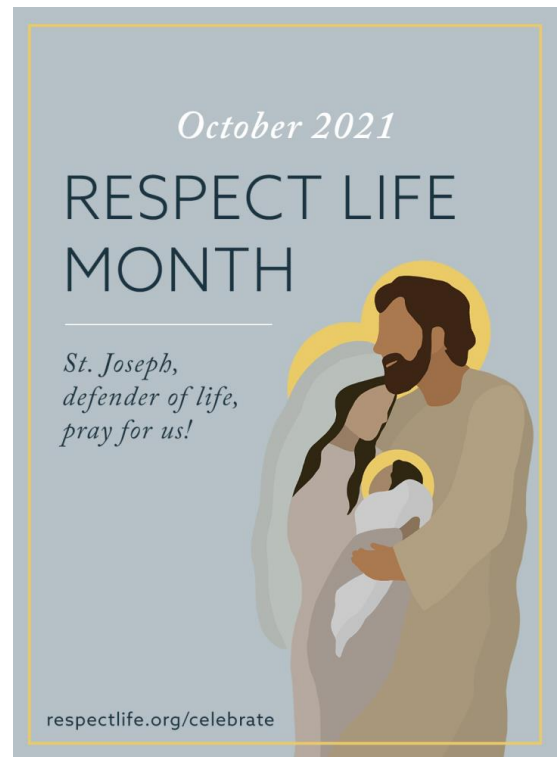
Sunday, October 3 from 2-3 P.M.
